

Civic Leadership Grant

The Civic Leadership Grant (CLG) is sponsored each year by the Indiana Political Action Committee for Education (I-PACE) to recognize ISTA members who, in addition to their work and family responsibilities, choose to run for state and certain local public office.

The CLG is not a candidate recommendation (sometimes called an "endorsement") but, instead, recognizes the commitment to public service that running for office represents.

The granting of a CLG is not based upon any political or partisan affiliation.

The CLG is reflective of I-PACE guiding principle #6

Work to build more **local and community support for public education** (i.e., creating plans to support local initiatives, local relationships with public officials, coalitions and issue advocacy, as well as working to engage members locally in politics).

Application Guidelines & Process

To Which Elected Offices Does a CLG Apply?

All publicly elected offices at the state level and the following elected offices at the local level:

CLG also will be awarded to reimburse members for serving as Precinct Committeeperson, as well as a state party convention delegate.

The CLG does not apply to federal offices.

I-PACE Civic Leadership Grant Application

Must be submitted prior to the filing deadline for the office for which you are running.

WHAT ARE THE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS?

- 1. Must be a current ISTA member (any classification).
- 2. Must currently give to I-PACE through the Options Guaranteed program.
- 3. Must establish a campaign committee prior to the candidate filing deadline for the office being sought.
- 4. Must commit to attend at least one I-PACE or NEA-sponsored political/campaign training opportunity during the period leading up to the election in which the member runs. I-PACE staff will work with recipient to schedule at least one training.
- 5. Must be submitted prior to the filing deadline for the office for which you are running.
- 6. Expenditures must be consistent with I-PACE goals.
